RE: Neighborhood Works – Project Recommendation Approval


Dear Rusty –

City staff and myself have reviewed the recommended projects submitted by the Neighborhood Advisory Council selection committee for the Neighborhood Works program. The following projects were submitted and approved as presented:

- Bissett – Hillcrest/Nichols Pedestrian Safety and Accessibility Improvements - \$78,000
- Brentwood – Improvements to Kirkwood Park - \$99,999
- Galloway – Galloway Neighborhood/Intersection Improvements - \$0 (City maintenance budget)
- Grant Beach – Richard Napieralski Community Garden Improvements - \$3,810
- Greater Parkcrest – Projects to Enhance Livability - \$47,289
- Greater Parkcrest – Sanford Park Phase 2 - \$52,741
- Mark Twain – Keep it Green - \$20,000
- Midtown – Alleyway Cleanup - \$5,000
- Midtown – Silver Springs Park Water Line - \$270
- Rountree – ADA Compliant Sidewalks and Ramps - \$85,499
- Westside – Tweaking the Courts - \$5,872
- Woodland Heights – Repair & Restoration of Charlie Norr Community Center - \$69,000
- Woodland Heights – Alley Grading & Pothole Repair - \$25,000
- NAC – Speed Boards for Neighborhood Use - \$24,000
